

QBE GoFlex Travel Insurance – FAQ

How is GoFlex different from Single Trip Travel Insurance?

GoFlex covers unlimited trips within the policy period (e.g. 90, 180, or 365 days), with each trip up to 45 or 90 days depending on the plan. Single Trip covers one journey only, up to 182 days.

Are the benefits different between GoFlex and Single Trip?

Yes. GoFlex generally offers more benefits, such as Abduction Incident Support, Food Poisoning Allowance, and Severe Turbulence Trauma Support.

What's the maximum travel duration per trip under GoFlex?

45 days for the 90-day plan.
90 days for the 180-day and annual plans.

If I have several trips in 3 months, should I choose GoFlex or Single Trip?

GoFlex 90-day plan is usually more convenient and cost-effective for 3 or more short trips. If any trip exceeds 45 days, Single Trip is required.

Is GoFlex more cost-effective than buying multiple Single Trip policies?

For frequent short trips, GoFlex is generally more economical and hassle-free than purchasing separate Single Trip policies.
