
Singapore SME Survey 2024

Interviewees were mostly unconcerned about the nefarious potential of AI, with only:









Workplace health and safety is improving, yet attention to mental health is waning



- 63% reported no workplace safety incidents this year, <u>up from 55% last year.</u>
- However, the proportion of SMEs that find mental health either very important or somewhat important fell slightly – <u>from 94% last</u> <u>year to 89% this year.</u>
- 51% of SMEs feel that mental health is very important within the WSH paradigm, <u>while 89%</u> <u>overall feel it's important.</u>
